- ✓ Lighting technology using T5 fluorescent lights c/w occupancy sensors;
- ✓ Building envelope designed to include insulation in the wall cavity and the roof, even in the garage area, windows are insulated double glazed units with Low E coating to reflect solar heat but permit light;
- ✓ High performance mechanical systems for HVAC are using the highest level of Energy Star rating products on the market today and this centre will be completely self-sustaining through the use of on-site emergency generation.

“I am extremely pleased that Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc. is now opened to serve our area in our Township of Smithville,” Mayor Katie Trombetta said. “The people of Smithville can be proud of this facility, which will provide a central location for customers, both residential and businesses with very accessible services.”
